WOMEN IN IAF

In recent years, the changing Indian socio-economic scenario has seen an increasing public demand for greater participation of women in all fields. The evolving new woman is discovering a whole new self. She in storming the male citadels everywhere and the Defence Services are not left untouched.

IAF is the first among the three services to induct women in all its branches. We have openings for women in the Flying, Ground Duty (Technical) and Ground Duty (Non-technical) Branches, where you can join as Short Service Commissioned Officers. Terms of engagement in Short Service Commission in Flying Branch is 14 years with no extension & for Ground Duty (Technical) Branches for a period of 10 yes which may be extended for four years subject to willingness, suitability, service years subject to willingness, suitability, service years subject to willingness.

Note: Age and Educational Qualification criteria for women are the same as applicable to male condidates in all the branches.

SELECTION PROCESS & MEDICAL EXAMINATION (MEN & WOMEN)

The selection process starts with written lest for various entries. A written test is conducted by UPSC for NDA & CDSE entries for Plying Branch, Similarly an Air Force Common Admission Test (AFCAT) is conducted by the IAF for Plying (SSC), Ground Duly (Technical) and Ground Duly (Non-technical) Branches. Those who quality the written test are called at any one of the Air Force Selection Boards at Dehradun, Mysore, Varanasi, Ganchinagar or Kancharapara for further testing. During AFSB, stage-1 testing comprising Churcher Porception & Discussion test (PP & DT) and intelligence test are conducted for all the entries. The candidates who quality stage-I are eligible to undergo stage-Il testing which involves Psychological Test, Group Tests and Interview. Candidates who have applied for Plying Branch would also be administered Computerised Plot Selection System (CPSS). Finally short-lated candidates are called for modulacl examination of the at IAM, Bengaluri or AFCME, New Dehi. Candidates recommended by AFSBs and declared medically if will be detailed for training in the order of All Inda Ment List Ment
