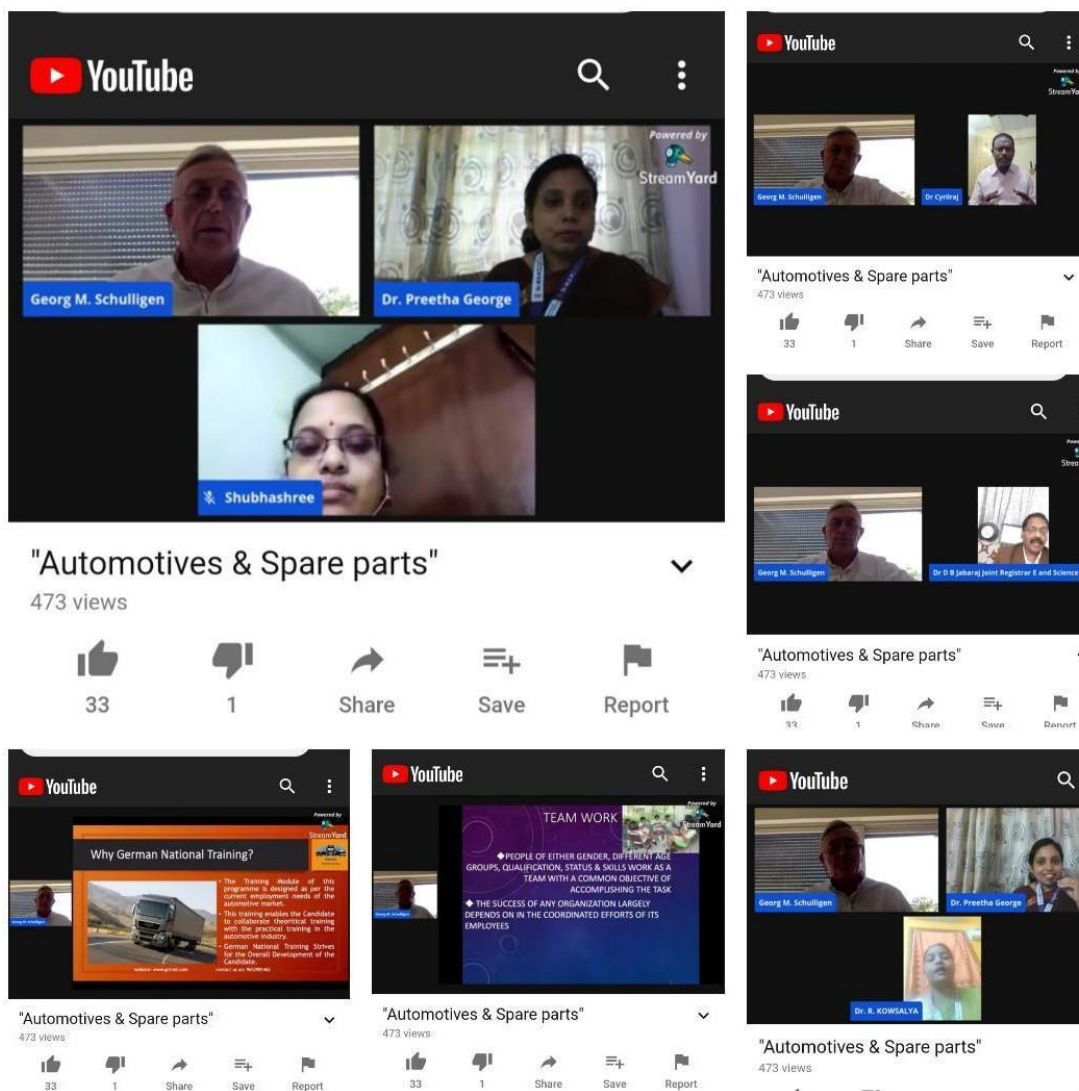


Engineering & Technology –I Year Event Report 2020
